Western Massachusetts Regional Coordinating Network

Scope of Services

The Western Massachusetts Regional Coordinating Network will provide homeless interventions over an 18-month period. The interventions that will be provided are:

- Regional Engagement and Assessment for Chronically Homeless (REACH) services and housing for 15 Tier 3 and 23 Tier 4 individuals; this intervention will leverage subsidized housing units in the community.
- Prevention, Diversion and Rapid ReHouse funding and services for the following:

The Network intends to provide assistance to Tier 3 families that are ineligible for Emergency Assistance/shelter/Toolbox from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The Network will hire a consultant Program Director, who will monitor progress toward the grant's goals, staff the Network's Leadership Council, communicate between Network members and to the public, and raise additional funds to support the Network and this project.

The Network will hire a consultant Data Analyst, who will collect, review and analyze data from the three participating Continua of Care, and report on the data to the Interagency Council on Housing and Homelessness.
