

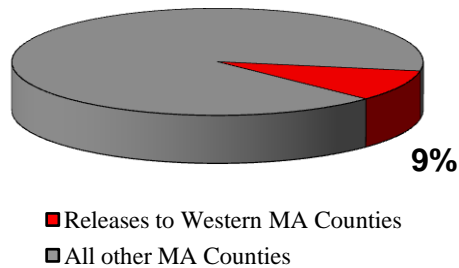

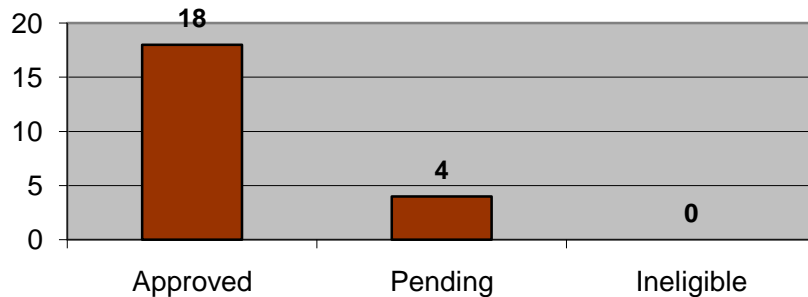
### November 2009

Of the **233** MA DOC releases in November 09, 22 were released to the Western MA Region.

#### MassHealth Coverage Status at Release



MassHealth Applications are submitted for each releasing offender when they are within 60 days of release. In November 09, 81% of releases to Western MA Region returned with healthcare coverage.
