

### Accomplishments During Early Implementation

- **Leveraging Network partnerships and building employer relationships:** Network partners have stepped forward during this early stage of implementation! Of the 5 employers who have interviewed and/or hired Secure Jobs participants, 3 are Network Advisory members who represent diverse sectors (retail, education, government).
- **Access to childcare:** Our partnerships with local childcare providers, DHCD, and DTA are resulting in streamlined and/or prioritized access to childcare vouchers by Secure Jobs Connect families.
- **Opportunities for families in underserved regions:** During the past month we had our first enrollments into our Franklin County and our Berkshire County programs, overseen by ServiceNet.

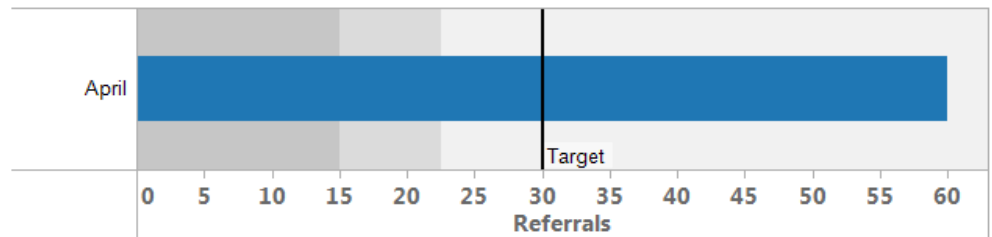

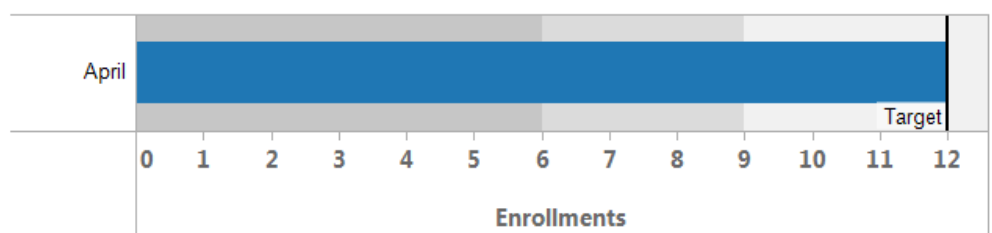


### Progress toward meeting project goals

As of May 1st, 2013, HomeBASE providers made **231** referrals to the project, exceeding the project's monthly and Year To Date (YTD) goals. The project is 97% of the way towards meeting its annual



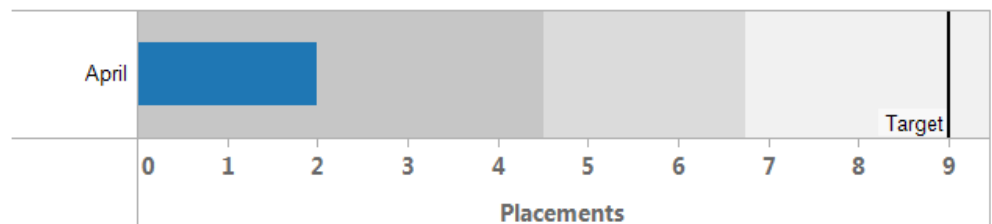
Secure Jobs staff have enrolled **35** parents into the project, meeting the project's monthly goal but falling 12% short of the project's YTD goal.



The current enrollment rate is **15%**, up slightly from last month.

Enrollments by track: **19** Job Readiness, **7** Occupational Skills, **9** Direct to Work

There were 2 placements into employment during the past month. There have been **6** placements overall, somewhat below the project's monthly and YTD goal.



The current placement rate is **17%**, the same as last month.
