

Final Data Report

Feb 2013 - Mar 2014

Ninety-five families have been enrolled into Secure Jobs Connect during the demonstration phase of the project. At the time of enrollment, 60% were receiving HomeBASE Rental Assistance, 27% were receiving HomeBASE Housing Assistance, and 13% were in shelter. Most enrollees were HOHs but 10% of enrollees were spouses/partners of the HomeBASE recipient. Additional descriptive information about enrollees and their work situations is below.


PARTICIPANT PROFILE: WHO ENROLLED INTO SJC?


Eighty-eight percent of SJC participants are women. Seventy percent are single HOHs while 30% have a partner or spouse in the household.


Forty-seven percent of enrollees are Latina/Latino, which reflects the HomeBASE participant population: Hispanic families are disproportionately impacted by homelessness within our region.


SJC families contain 202 children. Almost 300 persons are affected by the project.







WORK PROFILE: WHAT TYPE OF WORK WAS SECURED?

SJC enrollees gained work in diverse settings, filling dozens of occupational roles in 58 different local businesses. The majority of these positions exceeded 30 hours per week.
