
Description The number and composition of young adult families identified

232

young adult families were identified during the 2015 Point in Time Count, 95% of which were staying in Emergency Shelter or hotel/motel units.




#### **Notes**

- Young adult families comprised 26% of all families identified during the Point in Time Count
- The majority of young adult families **(86%)** were living in Hampden County shelters or hotel/motel overflow units
- Hispanic families were over-represented among the young adult families.
