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Goal: Increase permanent housing options overall while increasing the number of dedicated beds for targeted populations.

● 1. Increase the number of PSH beds	635	589	↑ 8%	Y
• 90% of more of PSH are dedicated to chronically homeless households	143	122	↑ 17%	N
● 2. Increase the number of RRH units for all household types (unless RRH inventory is sufficient)	110	5	↑ >100%	Y
• Increase RRH units for families with children by 5% or more	100	0	↑ 100%	Y

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Goal: Reduce the number of people becoming homeless

● • Decrease first time homelessness (Metric 5)	1199	1345	↓	11%	Y
● • Decrease returns to homelessness (Metric 2)	16%	12%	↑	4%	N

Goal: Help people become quickly and stably housed

● 1. Decrease LOT homeless (Metric 1)

• Average LOS (days) in ES and TH	135	133	↑	2%	N
• Median LOS (days) in ES and TH	66	72	↓	8%	Y

● 2. Increase job and income growth (CoC-funded TH and PH projects only) (Metric 4)

• Increased total income among CoC stayers	27%	44%	↓	17%	N
• Increased total income among CoC leavers	45%	41%	↓	4%	Y

● 3. Increase successful placement and retention of housing (Metric 7)

• Successful exits from ES, TH, and RRH	40%	31%	↑	9%	Y
