

Preventing and Ending Homelessness

In MA: for every 100 extremely low income households there are 48.6 affordable and available housing units.

Nationally: 1 in 10 young adults between the ages of 18 and 25 experience some form of homelessness over the course of a year.

In FY19 to date in Western MA:

- Housing Consumer Education Centers (HCECs) provided 12,754 households assistance to obtain or preserve housing
- RAFT resources stabilized 1,256 tenancies for families and individuals at risk of homelessness
- Secure Jobs placed 85 heads of family households into jobs. FY18 placements saw a 93% job retention rate and zero returns to shelter.
- Over 135 young adults received assistance to become stably housed.
