Shelter Update:

ServiceNet:

Greenfield: full with a wait list

Northampton: some capacity at interfaith shelter

Pittsfield: currently at St. Joe's HS - about 40-43 people

Craig's Doors: continuing with outreach efforts at encampments; purchasing tents, dropping off water; guest since 2015, signed lease and picked up keys last Friday. Focused on deepening case management.

Hilltown Health Center update: Dr. Bossie is providing medical services at Manna Soup Kitchen in Northampton - attending every Monday, 9 am - 3:30 pm with case management support.

5 Franklin Street Housing: Open House Party, Tuesday, August 2, 5-7 pm. ALL are welcome who are connected to this work (see <u>Invitation HERE</u>). 10 official referrals to the building. 4 are in pre-referral process. 2 remain to be identified (16 total). All referrals are through the Three County CoC coordinated entry process.

Data Update: Small group met to discuss how we want to look at data. Going to experiment with quarterly reporting, looking at in-flow and out-flow and sub-populations (e.g.,veterans, youth and young adults) and race and ethnicity. July through September will be our first data look (at October meeting).

Three County CoC Emergency Housing Vouchers Update: Of the 68 EHVs issued to the 3 County CoC, 27 people have been housed thus far. (Salasin Project shared how one of them is an individual they have been working with for 2 years). Fantastic work!
