Way Finders

- just resubmitted application for Secure Jobs (every 5 years) in that process noted the lack of referrals from Hampshire County and Berkshire County taking steps to increase outreach; emphasizing the unique resource of flex funds to address myriad obstacles to work.
- Noted the great partnership with MHA

Mental Health Association - new employment services program, developing new partnerships, all connected to getting and sustaining housing.

Other topics discussed:

- Seeing increase in immigrants who would like to work but do not have the papers they need to work while at the same time they are required to work...a catch-22. Any guidance is welcome!
- Also looking to increase understanding of available resources to assist immigrants as they
 make their transition to living here reaching out to Center for New Americans and other
 organizations

• Discussed the need to improve the system to obtain employment outcome data - a top MassHire legislative priority is data matching so that the state provides the data they need to report on the outcomes everyone wants - need to take the burden off of state colleges to produce the data without sufficient state support
